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The picture clip is fun to watch and visualizing the walk will make the following directions even easier.

Don't forget sunblock, a hat and your camera! Enjoy! The map is on the 2nd page.

Directions Walk 16 by Beautiful Plakias (<https://beautifulplakias.com>)

Walk along the fence next to the Plakias Bay hotel and take the second path to the right (there is a sign that says Kalypso) – the path gradually goes up and gets steeper towards the end – when you see a gate walk up to it and go through - keep following the path – the path will go through a small opening between rocks and when you are through and down the rocks it gets a bit tricky –

If you want to enjoy the best views over Plakias Bay from the top at 204 meters above sea level, turn left here and walk alongside the plateau on top till you can go left and walk up to the plateau – there is no real path so just find your way – on the plateau walk towards the sea and the big pile of rocks for the best views – walk back the same way and continue the walk

- on your right hand you will have to find a path that goes down and is marked with red (or blue) dots - once you found it just keep following the dots and you will end up on a paved road –go right on this road – pass the big gate at Kalypso and stay on the same road till you see steps going up just after a parking – go up the steps and the dirt road that follows will take you to the west side of Damnoni Beach – pass the beach and stay on the same dirt road – when you reach a cross section take the paved road across straight ahead – take the first dirt road on the left – right after you pass a single house you turn right (there usually is a sign for Plakias) – you will cross a field, usually with gates on both sides – *don't forget to close them again* – you walk through olive groves till you see a path on your right going down (looks like a dried up river bed) – when your down take a left turn – follow this path and it will lead you back to Plakias
