Directions Walk 13 by Beautiful Plakias (https://beautifulplakias.com)

You start at the bridge in Plakias and walk towards the pier - you take the first right in between the supermarket and the "hippie" shop - you pass some tavernas and other shops - right after you pass big parking areas on both sides the road curves to the left - cut the corner by passing the house on the right and turn right - the road will take you left over a small bridge - keep walking straight ahead until you see a fork in the road, just before the Plakias Youth Hostel - you take a right turn on the road that goes north - at the next cross section keep going straight ahead and walk up the steep road towards Myrthios - don't forget to look back for the great views towards Plakias — when you see a taverna on the top of the road take the steps up on the left side of the taverna — stay on the steps till you reach a small parking area alongside the main road with a handicraft shop in front of you — take a right turn onto the main road — you will find a folklore museum when you go left, right in front of a small church — walk back a few meters and turn right to take the steps up to a small square with a statue — walk over the square and when you hit a road go left between the houses and immediately after the houses go right — stay on this road — you will pass Myrthios cemetery and the road takes a left turn and starts going up — after a hairpin to the right keep going on the same road, don't take a turn to the left — stay on this road that will pass a church before connecting with the main road —

If you want to have a look at the village of Mariou and the picturesque church build against the rocks walk into the village. The church is at the end on your left hand. Then walk back and follow the directions again

- take the first left (right of course when you come walking back from the village) and start walking up - after 150 meters you pass a road to the left – keep walking up and right after a sharp corner to the right you will pass a small chapel – a little further you will pass some house – you will be walking up for another kilometre where you will pass a farm house – 150 meters passed the house you will start to go down, after you opened and closed a gate, making a right turn – the uneven and bit rocky path winds its way down with a few hairpins - at the first fork in the road you take a right turn and walk passed a house (sometimes there is a closed gate you need to open and close again) – you walk down to the main road, straight into a church—take a left onto the main road – after 800 meters you take the first turn off the main road and start walking up again – stay on this road, don't take the left turn right after a house – the road bends to the right shortly after – after about 1km take the right road at the fork and you walk down into Asomatos – the Oriseum of Papa Michalis is through an alley on the right side, follow the signs.

The bus stop is right in front of the village, on the west side.
